DEADLINE: Thursday, June 3rd

DESCRIPTION: About the *Triumphant Scholars Academic Award*

The *Triumphant Scholars Academic Award* was created to encourage current and active Word of Restoration International Church (WORIC) ***first time in college (2 awards)*** and ***returning to college (1 award)*** students to advance his/her academic achievements by pursuing post-secondary education; and to show support for and acknowledge leadership potential and community service efforts. This award places special emphasis on students who have persevered and remained steadfast during these unprecedented pandemic times. The scholarship will be awarded based on the applicant's Eligibility, Criteria, Application, and Essay as outlined below:

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be considered

- 1) The applicant must be a current member of WORIC and active in Youth Ministry worship experiences and events.
- 2) The applicant must be accepted to an accredited, post-secondary educational institution (College/University/Professional School), seeking a certificate, two, or four year degree during the current academic year.
- 3) The Applicant must confirm current full-time registration/enrollment status at a post-secondary educational institution.

NOTE: Full-time undergraduate = at least 12credit hours

CRITERIA: In addition to the applicant's Eligibility

- 1) The applicant must submit application with ALL required documents on, before, but not later than the deadline date. These documents include:
 - a) Completed application with typed essay
 - b) Ministry Activity Reference Form and
 - c) Copy of current "unofficial" transcript (or final report card)
 - d) Proof of Registration/Enrollment

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications are available at www.woric.org/coming-up.
- Complete the application and upload all supplemental materials via the online application, or attach a PDF file and email the entire packet to general@woric.org.
- Proof of Registration/ Enrollment Status may be submitted no later than July 9th.

SELECTION PROCESS:

A Scholarship Selection committee will review applications, tally points, and award recipients. The Scholarship Selection Committee reserves the right to rescind an award should a recipient's circumstances change (such as failure to go to school, academic failure, etc.).

AWARD PAYMENT PROCESS:

Once recipients have been selected checks will be mailed to the school mailing address pending proof of registration/enrollment and unofficial transcript. Check processing requires approximately two weeks.
